I understand if this is not paid in full by the due date, my spot will be given to the next camper in line and I will still be obligated to pay in full what is owed for the registered week. _____
- 2) I understand and give my consent to have my credit card drafted if **I do not** pay in full by the 2 week deadline plus a \$25 late fee. I understand if **I do not** give my credit card number and consent to have my card automatically drafted by “FHP” (**only** in the event of non-payment as outlined in the payment terms contained within this application), my application will *not* be accepted or considered complete. SCHEDULES: I understand that it is my responsibility to review the daily schedule so that I know what to pack and bring for my child. Schedules are available through the Frisco Horse Park office (hereinafter referred to “FHP”) or on our website at www.friscohorsepark.org.

REGULAR CAMP HOURS: I understand that the official camp hours are from 9:00 am - 4:00 pm.

EARLY DROP-OFF AND LATE PICK-UP: Early drop off starts at 7:30 am and late pick up ends at 6:00pm. If you would like both of these options, the additional cost is \$50/week. If you choose only one of these options, then the additional charge is \$25. *You must indicate this option on the registration form and the additional payment is to be made with your final camp payment..*

DAMAGE RESPONSIBILITY: I agree that if my child(ren) damage any items that belong to “FHP” I will be responsible for replacing such items or repairing back to it’s original state as deemed acceptable by the Camp Director by the end of the week in which the damage occurred.

Missing Days: I understand that if my child misses a day for any reason, there is no reduction in tuition.

Inclement Weather: We cannot control Mother Nature or Inclement Weather. In the case of inclement weather, we will evaluate the down time away from the horses and if we feel time warrants make up, we will set up a riding situation after camp at the discretion of River Ranch Educational Charities. All camps affected will have a make up day at the horse park.  Initialed Consent_____

Lunch and Snacks: I understand that my child is to bring a nutritious sack lunch each day and a snack with an optional drink in the afternoon. If possible, please provide your child with a reusable water container with a strap attached. We are currently looking into offering Frisco Horse Park water bottles. If this works out, we will offer them for purchase in the office. This is a wonderful way to help the environment, maintain the cleanliness of the ranch and also a great way to encourage the kids to stay hydrated! We will provide water and/or electrolyte replacement for all campers throughout the day. If my child forgets their lunch, “FHP” staff will supply a lunch to the best of their availability and I agree to reimburse staff upon pick-up that day.

DROP- IN’S: I understand that if available, Campers can come to “FHP” as drop-in’s, with all policies outlined in this contract applying. Cost is \$60/day or \$75 with early drop-off & late pick-up. We will know availability for drop-in’s the week prior to each week. Please call the office to sign-up.

ORIENTATION: “New Camper Orientation” will be held Monday morning of camp from 9:00am-9:30am. It is my responsibility to be there for any further information and questions I may have.

FRISCO HORSE PARK - DISCIPLINARY GUIDELINES

The philosophy at our Horse Camp is to guide the children by love, reasoning and positive values. We believe there are no bad children, only children who sometimes have not learned to communicate their feelings in the proper way. In the event there is a disciplinary problem, certain measures must be taken in order to ensure that the child understands there are consequences to their actions and to hopefully teach them along the way how to effectively deal with problems that arise in a way that is beneficial to everyone. Examples of disciplinary problems are as follows, but not strictly limited to:

- * Profanity, talking inappropriately or rudely to the Staff or other children.
- * Any physical abuse to the other children or Staff, some examples being hitting, pinching, pulling hair, and throwing objects at each other.
- * Not acknowledging or ignoring the Staff's requests of participation in the program.
- * Not staying within the confines of the area designated for use by the Staff.

One written warning will be given to the Camper if any of the above incidents occur. In the event that any of these or other incidents occur again which the Director feels is not reflective of good, positive behavior, a second written incident report will be given and the Director will have the sole right to dismiss the Camper at their discretion, with no refund for the remainder of the week or any other weeks the Camper has signed up for (please refer to Financial Obligation of Application). The Director will try to fill any future weeks that the dismissed Camper is signed up for to replace his or her spot. If the Director can fill the spot, then any balance remaining for the weeks signed up for and owed will not be due. If the Director cannot fill the spots, then all money owed is still due as outlined in application.

The Director will discuss any issues with the parent and try to come up with an alternate solution (sitting out, doing extra work, redirection, etc.) first, but if the Director feels the Camper is impairing the safety and well being of the other Campers, then the Director will be forced to ask the parent to come and pick up their child as soon as possible, with the above stated consequences enforced. Counseling, redirecting and giving advice to the Campers is always the first steps when bad behavior occurs. We will try to bring any bad behaviors we are noticing to the parent's attention upon pickup that day so we can deal with them together and hopefully curtail any write-ups from occurring.

If Camper is found to be in possession of alcohol, illegal drugs, firearms, knives, or any other substance or item that the Director feels to be harmful to the other Campers, or if Director feels the Camper is a viable threat to the safety of the Camp or Campers, this will be grounds for immediate dismissal for the Camper, with the above financial policies strictly enforced.

These rules have to be enforced in order to maintain our high standard of goals set forth by the Camp. We want "FHP" to be a fun place for everyone. If there are Campers who continually misbehave, it takes time and energy away from the rest of the Campers who are trying to adhere to the rules and enjoy the activities. "FHP" encourages an open door policy. The communication between the "FHP" Staff and the parents is of utmost importance. If you, as a parent, feel there is any problem, please do not hesitate to talk to the Director or member of the staff as soon as possible.

_____ 1) **Registration of riders and agreement purpose.** In consideration of the payment of a fee and the signing of this agreement, I the following listed individual, and the parent or legal guardian thereto if a minor, do hereby agree to hire this Stable, a horse, tack and equipment, personnel and trail for the purpose of horseback or pony riding today and on all future dates:

_____ 2) **Agreement Scope and Territory Definitions:** This agreement shall be legally binding upon me the registered rider/visitor, and the parents or legal guardians thereof if a minor, my heirs, estate, assigns, including all minor children, and personal representatives; and it shall be interpreted according to the laws of the state and county of this Stables physical location. Any dispute by the rider/visitor shall be litigated in and venue shall be the county in which this Stable is physically located. If any clause, phrase, or word is in conflict with state law, then that single part is null and void. The term "HORSE" herein shall refer to riding or otherwise handling of horses, ponies, mules, or donkeys, whether from the ground or mounted. The term 'Rider/Visitor' shall herein refer to a person who rides a horse mounted or otherwise handles or comes near a horse from the ground. The terms "I", "WE", "ME", and "MY" shall herein refer to the above registered rider/visitor and the parents or legal guardians thereof if a minor.

_____ 3) **Activity Risk Classification:** I UNDERSTAND THAT: Horseback riding is classified as RUGGED ADVENTURE RECREATIONAL SPORT ACTIVITY and that there are numerous obvious and non-obvious inherent risks always present in such activity despite all safety precautions. According to NEISS (National Electronic Injury Surveillance Systems of United States Consumer Products) horse activities rank 64th among the activities of people relative to injuries that result in a stay at U.S. hospitals. Related injuries can be severe requiring more hospital days and resulting in more lasting residual effects than injuries in other activities. I/WE further understand that applicant may be participating in a 'WILDERNESS EXPERIENCE' and that the meaning of this term is defined as follows: THE PURSUIT OF ADVENTURE TYPE OF ACTIVITY IN A WILD, RUGGED, AND UNCULTIVATED AREA OR REGION, AS OF FOREST AND/OR HILLS AND OR MOUNTAINS AND OR PLAINS AND OR WETLANDS, WHICH WOULD LIKELY BE UNINHABITED BY PEOPLE AND INHABITED BY WILD ANIMALS OF MANY TYPES AND SPECIES TO INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO MAMMELS, REPTILES AND INSECTS, WHICH ARE NOT TAME, MAY BE SAVAGE AND UNPREDICTABLE IN NATURE AND ALSO WANDERING AT THEIR WILL.

_____ 4) **Understanding the Nature of A Stable Horse Facility:** I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS STABLE chooses its rental horses for their calm dispositions and sound basic training as is required for the use as riding horses for novice and beginning riders and THIS STABLE follows a responsible safety program. Yet, no horse is a completely safe horse. Horses are 5 to 10 times larger, 20 to 40 times more powerful and 3 to 4 times faster than a human, ***If a horse is frightened or provoked it may divert from its training and act according to its natural instincts which may include but are not limited to stopping quickly, changing direction quickly, shifting their speed at will, shifting its weight, bucking, rearing, kicking, biting, or running from danger.*** In the case of a visitor acting as a rider and the rider falls from a horse to the ground, it will generally be at a distance of from 3.5 – 5.5 feet, and the impact may result in injury to the rider. Horseback riding is the only sport where one much smaller, weaker predator animal (human) tries to impose its will on another much larger, stronger prey animal with a mind of its own (horse) and many ways each has a limited understanding of the other.

_____ 5) **Conditions of Nature:** I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS FACILITY/STABLE is not responsible for total or partial or minute acts, occurrences, or elements of nature that can scare a horse or animal, cause it to fall, or react in some other unsafe way: SOME EXAMPLES ARE: thunder, lightning, rain, wind, water, wild and domestic animals, insects, reptiles, which may walk, run, or fly near by, or bite a horse or person; irregular footing on out-of-door groomed or wild land which is subject to constant

change in condition according to weather, temperature and natural and man-made changes in landscape such as road construction.

_____ 6) **Awareness of Carry – On Objects and Sharp Noises, whether coming from the person or from the vicinity:** I UNDERSTAND THAT visitors and riders must not carry loose items closely on their person which may fall, blow away, flap in the wind, bounce, or make sharp noises, possibly scaring a horse or other animals. SOME EXAMPLES ARE: cameras flashing, hats blowing off, sounds from children’s toys, fire crackers, popping balloons, loud cell phones, highway construction, loud traffic, honking horns and the movement of large purses. Visitors must not make sharp, loud noises, such as screaming or yelling which may scare a horse or other animals. Visitors must not run towards the animals, specifically children, or the animal may respond as if it is being attacked. Children must show their excitement in a contained and controlled manner.

_____ 7) **Saddle Girths** – Natural Loosening: I UNDERSTAND THAT: Saddle girths (saddle fasteners around a horse’s belly) may loosen during a ride. If a rider notices this he/she must alert the nearest guide or wrangler as quickly as possible so action can be taken to avoid slippage of saddle and a potential fall from the animal.

_____ 8) **Accident/Medical Insurance:** I UNDERSTAND THAT: should emergency medical treatment be required, I and/or my own accident/medical insurance company shall pay for ALL such incurred expenses. My accidental/medical insurance company is _____ and my policy number is _____.

_____ 9) **Protective Headgear Offering:** I, for myself and on behalf of my child and/or legal ward, have been offered protective headgear (riding helmet) by THIS STABLE and do understand that the wearing of such headgear while mounting, riding, dismounting and otherwise being around horses, may prevent or reduce severity of some head injuries, and may even prevent death happening as the result of a fall or other occurrence. It is understood that STABLE-PROVIDED protective headgear may not be of perfect fit for each rider’s head and that once provided I/WE will be responsible for securing the helmet on this riders head at all times. I shall bring no claims, demands, actions, and causes of action, and/or litigation against THIS STABLES and ITS ASSOCIATES as stated above in this clause, for any economic and non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, property damage, sustained by me and/or my minor child or legal ward in relation to the premises and operations of THIS STABLE to include while riding, handling, or otherwise being near horses owned by or in the care, custody and control of THIS STABLE.

- * Be aware of your horse and other animals. They have a mind of their own. They will use it.
- * **No smoking is allowed in the barn area or during a trail ride.**
- * Sudden movements, running, loud noises & unfamiliar objects startle horses and other animals!
- * A group of horses tied up together is a potentially hazardous situation.
- * Do not enter the area of tied up horses without a guide.
- * Don't let your horse or pony eat or graze on the grass or on the trail.
- * Don't follow the horse ahead of you too closely. A horse finds tailgating about as annoying as you do – and he may kick. A good following distance is at least a horse length.
- * Don't pass your Trail Boss. She/he is up front to maintain control of ride.
- * Do not continue on a trail ride if a member of the group has dismounted.
- * If there are children on a trail ride that lose emotional control or if anyone does not follow the Trail Bosses instruction, they will be asked to walk back to the office and their ride will be complete.
- * Please ask questions before leaving if you have any doubt about reining and controlling your horse. These rules/guidelines are written with your safety in mind. Make sure we know you are a beginner!
- * There are hidden dangers on the trail and riders need to be alert at all times and in control of his/her horse. No cell phone use allowed on trail rides!
- * Enjoy your ride/visit and be safe so that you have many pleasant memories on horseback or pony and many pleasant memories (and visits) at FHP!
